7 Years Wars → 1754 - 1763

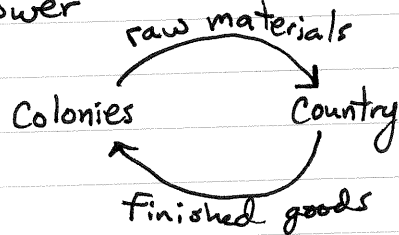
↳ European Name

Mercantilism

Government regulates the economy to
increase National power

- tariffs
- monopolies
- trade balance



* Slavery was used heavily
in this economy

France

most French colonists lived in St. Lawrence
River Valley

- moved to Mississippi + Ohio Valley
- allied with Native Americans for trade

Seven Years
War

Virginia Company + France claimed the Ohio Valley

- 21-year-old George Washington and British
troops tried to remove the French from
forts in Pennsylvania

1763 Treaty of Paris ended the war

- Britain gets Canada + Florida
- Native Americans now lived in British
controlled Ohio Valley + Mississippi

Pontiac's Rebellion

1763 Ottawa & Delaware

- besieged Detroit and killed settlers

Proclamation of 1763

No settlements were allowed west of the Appalachian Mountains

- enraged colonists who fought for this land
- ignored proclamation line

Republicanism

Idea that a king was not needed. Power held by land owning men.

Liberalism

- Task of government is to protect citizens natural rights
 - Life, Liberty, & Property
 - Consent of the governed

Great Awakening

• Early 1700s

• new denominations

• Methodists, Baptists,

• Religion became less of a hierarchy and more of an emotional bond

• Salvation is an individual choice in this movement

Breakdown in respect for political authority

- Economic Reasons (settling west of Appalachian)
- Republicanism & Liberalism
